City Winery Napa will be hosting a benefit release party with performances on April 28, raising money for the Music Connection, supporting music in Napa Valley schools, and Arts Council Napa Valley. "I love my life in wine," said Maguire in a press release, "but had I met David when I was 22, I think we could have had one really hot band. Working with him has helped me realize one of the great dreams of my life—to record my songs on a professionally-released album—and it has reawakened my passion for creating and performing music."
